REQUIREMENTS:

The images need to be jpeg files and sized with resolution (maximum) **1920 pixel horizontal by 1080 wide pixel at 100 dpi**. The maximum file size should be 2 mb or less. The web page has an upload facility.

IMAGES FILES:

File naming is the jpeg format and the name: **Month_Surname_Initial_ImageNumber_title**
e.g. May_Veivers_W_1_Swirling Waters. Month is first 3 letters only

By putting in an image number your images will appear in the order which **YOU** want.
